

Day 1: HOMETOWN -TORONTO

Complimentary airport pickup time range is between 10:00 am to 22:00 pm (Additional charge will be applied if other schedules fall outside said range), our tour guide will wear yellow uniform at meet up location.

[Airport pick-up tip] CAD \$ 8.00 / person
[Friendly remind] Hotel check-in time: 3pm or after. Most hotels require a security deposit when check in and will be refunded in full when check out, subject to an inspection of the room. (Credit card: approximately CAD150-CAD250, transation take around one - three weeks) or (Cash: approximately CAD250-CAD500)

Day 2: TORONTO - PENNSYLVANIA

Depart from Toronto in the morning and transfer to the legendary Penn's Cave. Located in Pennsylvania, it is America's only all-water cavern & farm-nature-wildlife park. You can take a boat tour (Fee apply) to explore the cave. Arrive at the hotel in late evening.

Day 3: PENNSYLVANIA ~ WASHINGTON D.C. ~ NEW JERSEY

Today proceed to the capital of US - Washington D.C., where you can discover the epic buildings that represent US, such as: Capitol, White House, Lincoln Memorial and Washington Monument. Then departing for New York City in afternoon, we will visit One World Trade Center Observatory (Fee Apply), enjoy unparalleled views of the Manhattan skyline, or join Harbor cruise (Fee apply) enjoy panoramic view of Statue of Liberty. Arrive at the hotel in late evening. (Note: May change to Rockefeller Center due to weather or special condition)

Day 4: NEW YORK CITY TOUR ~ NEW JERSEY ~ BOSTON

Enter New York City in the morning and explore Times Square, one of the busiest pedestrian areas in the world, or your choice to visit the famous Madame Tussauds Wax Museum(Fee apply). Then we go to The Intrepid Museum (Fee apply) which is an immersive and fun place. After dinner, proceed to the capital of Massachusetts to visit the famous campus of Harvard University and pass by MIT. Afterward, visit Boston Harbor which is the historic site of Treedom Trail. Arrive at the hotel in late evening

Day 5: BOSTON ~ TORONTO

Depart the hotel in the morning, pass by Albany, the capital city of New York, enjoy the nice scenery along the way back to Toronto. Before crossing the border, we will make a brief stop at Duty Free Shop where you can find your tax-free and great value items all year round. The journey will end at

Toronto in the late evening, and return back to Toronto hotel. Day 6: TORONTO - KINGSTON - OTTAWA - MONTREAL [FREE 2 BREAKFAST EACH ROOM]

We'll depart Toronto early in the morning traveling to Kingston, which was originally established as a fort back in 1673. We'll see a historic Canadian locomotive, government buildings and pass by the Royal Military College, the Queen's University and the residence of the first Prime Minister of Canada, We'll then proceed to Ottawa, Will visit Parliament Hill (Exterior), Ottawa River, Rideau Canal and the Canadian Museum of Civilization (Fee apply). After that, will visit the Canadian War Museum (Fee apply), which houses a number of exhibitions and memorials about Canadian military history. Then we will visit Sussex Drive where a number of embassies are located as well as the Canadian Prime Minister's home and Rideau Hall. In the evening, we will arrive in Montreal and you can explore the city's exciting nightlife.

Day 7: MONTREAL - QUEBEC CITY

Visit the Saint Joseph's Oratory of Mount Royal (Donation CAD\$5/ person) and Notre Dame Basilica (Donation CAD \$16 /person), [Will not be allowed to visit if there are any large-scale events/ in the midst of a Sunday mass]. Also take the ride of the highest Sky Wheel You can also take Canada's highest Montreal Sky Wheel (Fee apply), with a panoramic view of the historic old port, the bustling city center, and the banks of the St. Lawrence River. * Or we will visit the Montreal Biodome (Fee apply) which is a facility located at Olympic Park, that allows visitors to walk through replicas of four ecosystems found in the Americas. Afterwards, we will see the Olympic Stadium (Exterior), a multi-purpose stadium in Canada, located at Olympic Park of Montreal. Built in the mid-1970s as the main venue for the 1976 Summer Olympics. On the way to Quebec City, we'll have the French country style lunch (Fee apply) in the traditional maple syrup farm. Maple Sugar Lunch meal (Fee Apply), Otherwise, private Maple Sugar farm experience package \$12 per person to enter (including the museum and maple lollipop tasting). Rich in French culture and history, Quebec City is known for its antique shops where treasures can be found around every corner. First, visit the Quebec tower (Fee apply) (Subject to building opening permission) to view city skyline. Then explore European style Old Quebec City, rich in French culture and history. You can also have a nice, delicious French dinner (Fee apply) in the romantic city.

*** If we can't visit the observation Montreal Sky Wheel due to unforeseen circumstances, we will instead visit the Montreal Biodome (Fee Apply) or other attractions. **

Day 8: QUEBEC CITY - 1000 ISLAND - TORONTO

Travel to Thousand Islands. You can take an optional 1000 Islands boat cruise (Fee apply) or 1000 Islands helicopter (Fee apply) to see the historic Bold Castle on Heart Island. Afterwards, we'll return to Toronto hotel.

(* The cruise is only available during May ~ Oct*).

Dav 9: TORONTO HOTEL - NIAGARA FALLS - TORONTO HOTEL [FREE 2 BREAKFAST EACH ROOM]

In the morning, get ready for and experience of a lifetime to be amazed by the massive waterfalls, located on the Niagara River straddling the international border of the United States and Canada. Enjoy the Niagara Falls Skylon Tower (Fee apply), observation deck offers a spectacular 360 degree view of the entire city including the fall. Afterwards, transfer to Niagara Adventure Theater (Fee apply) on the big screen and discover the history that goes deeper than the formation of the falls. Then you can take Niagara City Cruise (Fee apply) Experience the beauty of Niagara Falls. Next, go Table Rock Centre and let your eyes wander as your witness the brand-new architectural features. Following this, go to Canada's most famous Ice winery in the Falls Lakeside area. Take a scenic route through the vineyards for ice wine tasting, variety of ice wines are also available for souvenirs. Afterwards return to Toronto and complete your pleasant journey.

Day 10: HOTEL - TORONTO DOWNTOWN - TORONTO PEARSON AIRPORT [FREE 2 BREAKFAST EACH ROOM]

Toronto is a thriving metropolis that is bursting at the seams with one-of-a-kind attractions and lively districts just waiting to be discovered. Departure from designated location in the morning, go to the heart of downtown area, pass by old city hall, university of Toronto, Chinatown etc... Then head to CN Tower (Exterior) the iconic Canadian landmark. After that hop on board the Toronto Island Cruise (Fee apply - around April to Oct) to experience the bustling waterfront and sail past the nearby Toronto Islands. After lunch (Fee apply), stop at the historic Casa Loma (Fee apply), a Gothic castle that boasts 5-acre gardens and secret tunnels that meander throughout the property. Walk around the grounds and explore the castle's many suites and halls as your guide tells you about how the building was constructed and informs you of the many films and television shows that have filmed here.

Next to little Canada (Fee apply), Explore the Uniqueness and Diversity of Canada in One Space in Downtown Toronto. Afterwards, Departure at the Pearson Airport, check-in on your own, and return to your hometown by plane to complete your pleasant journey.


